A <b>curved</b> line changes its direction continually from point to point.	A <b>straight</b> line continues in the same direction from point to point.

Instructions for PDF: print on cardstock and laminate. Cut out line cards and title cards.

A nice introduction to this work is to use a piece of string and show the child the difference between straight and curved lines with the string.

For an elementary student who has completed the first “Types of Lines” work with curved and straight lines, this is a nice extension.

You may want to label the backs of each card with a “c” for curved and an “s” for straight so that the child can check their own work.
