Show the child how to place “Plant” and “Food” at the top of a rug. Help them sort the pictures.

There are books called “Welcome Books” (available at Amazon and Scholastic) that detail some of these processes—”From Tomato to Ketchup” and “From Sap to Syrup” are two of them.
